RR/CC Begins Mailing Senate District 32 Vote by Mail Ballots to Pomona Voters *Special General (Runoff) Election Scheduled on May 14, 2013*

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing more than 15,000 Vote by Mail ballots to Pomona voters for the May 14, 2013 Senate District 32 Special General (Runoff) Election. The RR/CC reminds Pomona residents that the last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot is Tuesday, May 7.
